## What is it?

**T**he Multi-County New Landowner Program is a series of meetings, seminars, and field days designed to provide information and resources related to agriculture, natural resources, wildlife, and land stewardship for new landowners in Austin, Colorado, Fayette, and Washington counties. Participants in the program will hear from Extension experts in various fields about best management practices they can implement on their own property.

## What does the program cost?

If attending **all sessions**

\$125.00 per person or \$200.00 per couple

*\$35.00 savings per person for entire series  
or \$120.00 savings per couple for entire series*

If attending **select sessions**

\$20.00 per person for each session
